How to get a Student Loan at Pacific Rim Early Childhood Institute

- 1 Register as a student at www.earlychildhoodeducator.com
- 2 Choose a start date at least 8 weeks in the future
- 3 Complete the "Student Loan Timetable" below
(only fill in dates for courses you are planning to take over a 52 week period)
- 4 Complete the attached "Long Term Duration Student Contract"
- 5 Submit the timetable and contract to the administrator for approval
- 6 Submit a copy of valid government issued photo ID to the administrator
- 7 Apply for a Student Aid BC Loan at www.aved.gov.bc.ca/studentaidbc/ila/
- 8 Send a copy of your Notification of Assessment to the administrator once you receive it

Part Time 45% Course Load

Duration: Students are expected to complete one course every 10 weeks for the period of their loan.

There are eight 10 week courses in the Basic ECE Certificate program. In one year students can apply for up to 5 courses part time. Loans periods may not exceed a year so a new loan application, contract and timetable must be done every 52 weeks.

The practicums are completed in the final 11 weeks of the basic certificate program.
