POSITION:

The District of Tofino is looking for **two** qualified candidates to fill the casual position of Child Care Relief Worker.

Reporting to the Daycare Supervisor, the Child Care Relief Worker assists with the day-to-day operations of the Community Children's Centre. In accordance with the Community Care and Assisted Living Act – Child Care Licensing Regulation, a Child Care Relief Worker must:

- Be at least 19 years of age
- Be able to provide care and mature guidance to children
- Possess, a minimum, an Early Childhood Educator Assistant Certificate in BC
- Possess a current Child Safe First Aid certificate
- Have relevant work experience

HOURS OF WORK

This is a casual relief position. Specific hours and days of work will be scheduled on an as needed basis. The hourly wage for this position is \$21.23 plus an additional 14.8% in lieu of benefits, vacation and statutory holidays. This position is subject to a probationary period during which time the wage will be \$19.11. This is a union position and is subject to the terms and conditions of the collective agreement between CUPE Local 118 and the District of Tofino.
