Terms of Employment: for permanent positions:

Additional Wage Enhancement:

-Through the Ministry of Child and Family Development there is an additional \$4.00 per hour as per the ECE Wage Enhancement for B.C. ECE licensed staff. This is at the discretion of the Province of BC and may be modified or terminated at any time.
