- Registration with Early Childhood Educators of British Columbia (ECEBC)
- Experience creating, organizing, planning and implementing for an early learning program
- Demonstrated ability to work as part of a team including district and school staff, parents and children.
- Strong problem-solving and organizational skills
- Ability to work with minimal supervision
- Excellent interpersonal and communication (oral and written) skills
- Some knowledge of standard office equipment including computers for instructional use
- Ability to physically be able to perform all aspects of the position
