CHILDMINDING

Reporting to the Recreation Coordinator, childminding staff are responsible for the temporary care of children ages three months to eight years of age. Working with volunteers, you will be responsible for the care, safety and well being of multiple children at one time. You will be required to display an understanding of the healthy development of children in this age group and to clearly communicate with children and their parents in a positive, caring and respectful manner. You are an efficient, highly organized, detail orientated, multi-tasker looking to work in a fast paced environment.

- Ensure the health and safety of children in the YMCA's care
- Sign children in and out of the space
- Provide excellent customer service
- Feed, change and engage children
- Ensure proper care and cleanliness of program spaces and equipment
